Who should undertake this Qualification?

To work on a building site in Australia it's a requirement that all personnel hold a **Construction Induction certificate**. This card must be carried on your person at all times. This course is designed for self-employed persons, labourers, apprentices, trainees, trades-persons, supervisors and project managers.

All students are required to competently complete the theory assessment. The theory assessment includes a multiple choice paper at the end of the training. If a competent mark is not scored, the student will have to re-enrol into the course and pay the full course fee.

Students to provide a pen and note pad and wear comfortable clothing. If an invoice is required please contact Training Aid Australia's head office.

Training ID Requirements

If you are completing the Construction Induction White Card you must provide 100 points evidence of identity, this can include:

Students to provide a pen and note pad and wear comfortable clothing. All participants are required to competently complete all assessments.

Certification

Successful participants will receive a WorkCover Statement of Completion. This certificate is valid for 60 days. The actual Card is issued and posted by WorkCover NSW usually within 30 days. This course is Australian Qualification Framework accredited and Nationally Recognised Training CPCCOHS1001A – Work Safely in the construction Industry Unit of Competency from the Construction, Plumbing and Services Integrated Framework Training Package 2008.
