Assessment requirements	Pre-requisite: A current Apply First Aid HLTFA311A, Provide First Aid HLTAID003 or Apply Advanced First Aid HLTFA412A certificate must be supplied upon enrolment. We offer public attendance courses at our Sydney CBD training centre on George St. If your organisation is interested in a private / in-house booking to have this course delivered to a group of staff, please contact our head office to discuss booking options. The delivery can be programmed to fit in with your staff and company schedule, at your venue or ours. Physical Requirements: It is important to note that this course requires a level of physical ability to complete practical assessments. All students are required to perform 2 minutes of CPR on an adult manikin and baby manikin on the floor. In addition to this, all students must perform 2 minutes of bag-valve-mask resuscitation and 2 minutes of compressions only resuscitation. If your health or fitness will not allow you to demonstrate this, you will not be awarded a nationally accredited certificate for HLTAID006 Provide Advanced First Aid. We can however issue a non accredited certificate of attendance for Advanced First Aid. Students are advised to check if this option meets their workplace / industry requirements before attending the training.

Assessment	Assessment Outcomes: Competent or Not Competent
submission process, support and outcomes	For any learner who is unable to competently complete all assessment tasks, the facilitator will attempt to make reasonable adjustments to the methods of assessment. If the learner is still deemed not competent, they will need to re-sit the training course and additional fees will apply.
Recognition of Prior Learning	Students choosing to undertake RPL will need to be sent an RPL guide for their course. In order to be eligible for RPL, the student must demonstrate <i>currency</i> in that particular subject. I.e. a student cannot submit evidence from 5 years prior and request it be applied directly to their new competency. They must show how they have since applied those skills and that they are current.
Course completion	Once a competent mark is issued for all assessment activities, learners will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for HLTAID006 Provide Advanced First Aid & HLTAID007 Provide Advanced Resuscitation. These Units of Competency are Nationally Recognised Training from Health Training Package.
